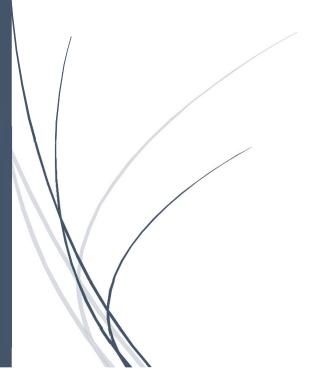

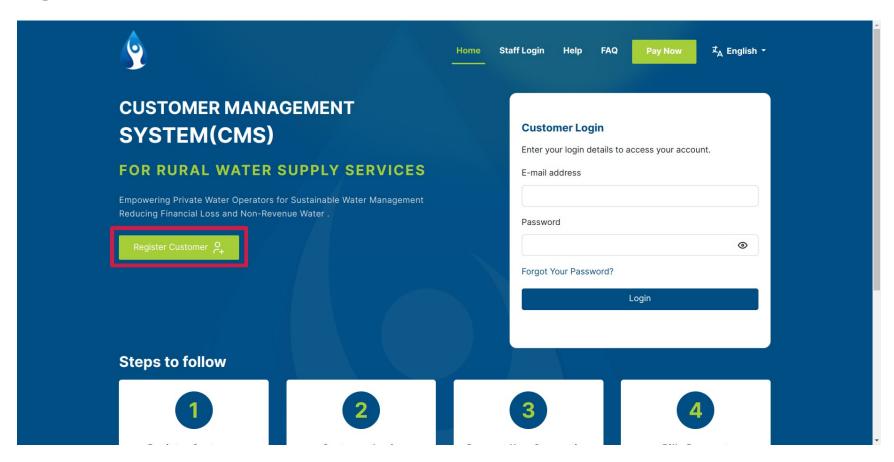

Product Perspective

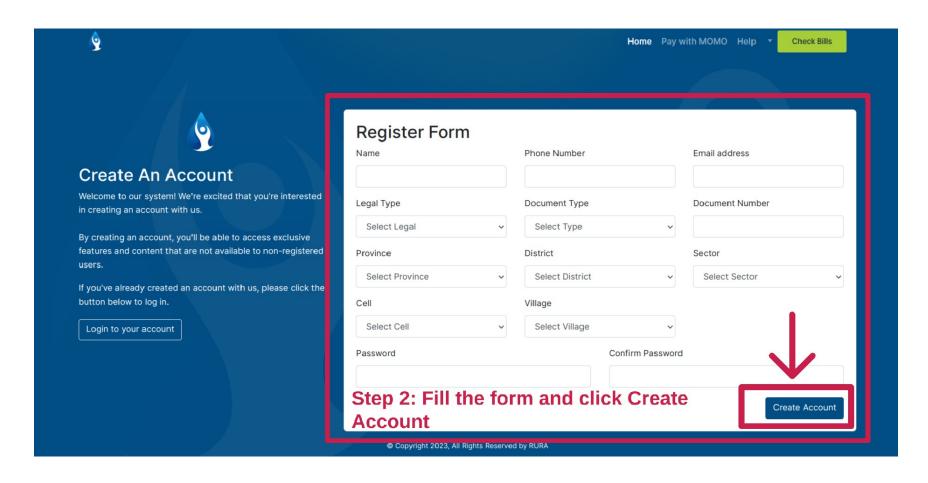

Additionally, the system will include a feature for the automated submission of regulatory fees. This will be achieved through direct integration with CLMS (Converged Licensing Management System), streamlining the regulatory compliance process and reducing the burden on water supply operators.

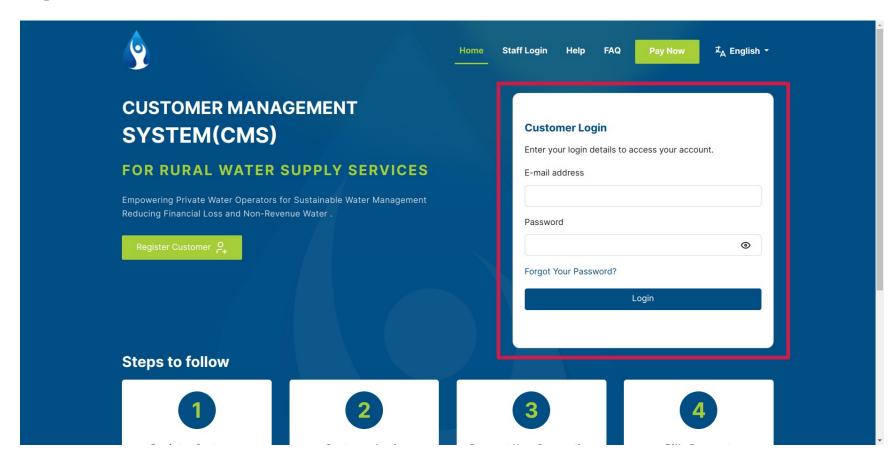


Step 1: Click Register Customer to create a login account.



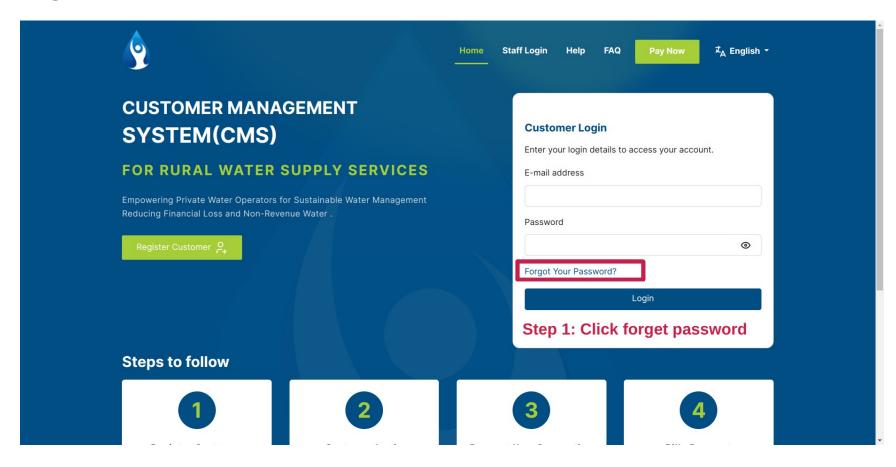
Step 2: Fill the form and click the Create Account Button

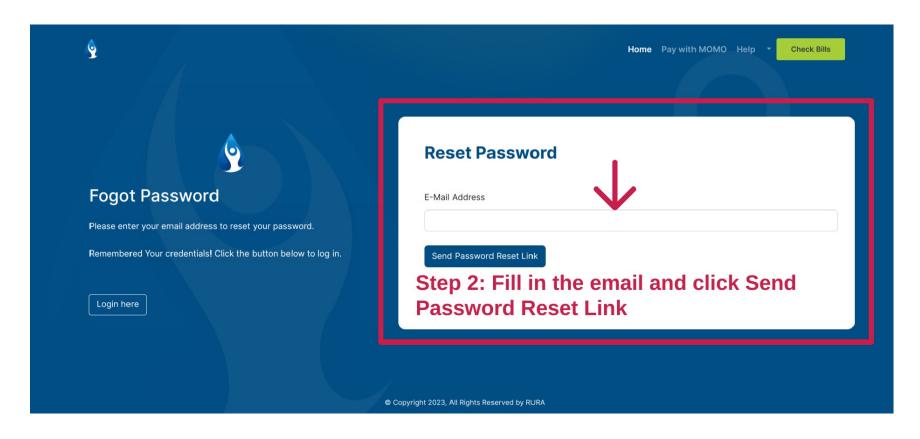


Step 1: Fill out the form accordingly and click Login

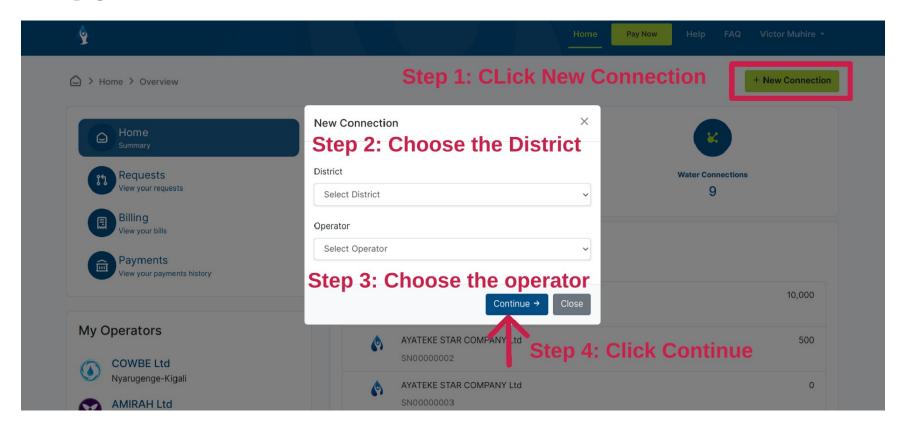


Step 1: Click forgot you password

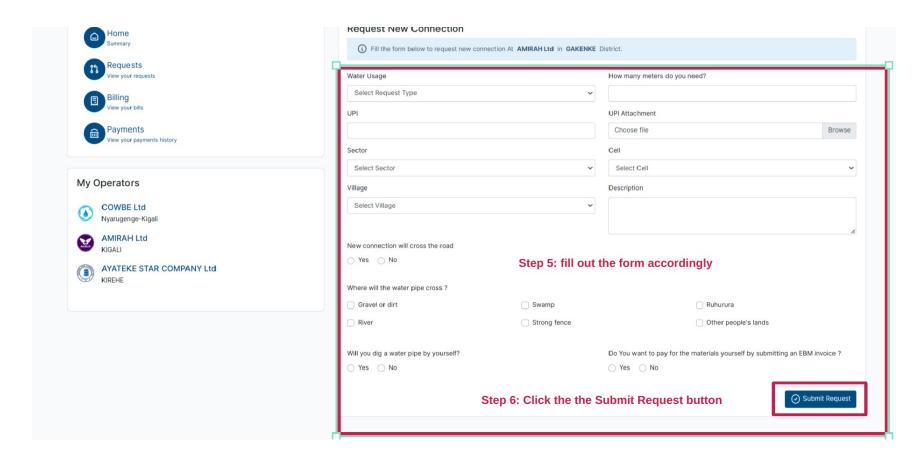


Step 2: Fill in the email and click the Send Password Reset Link

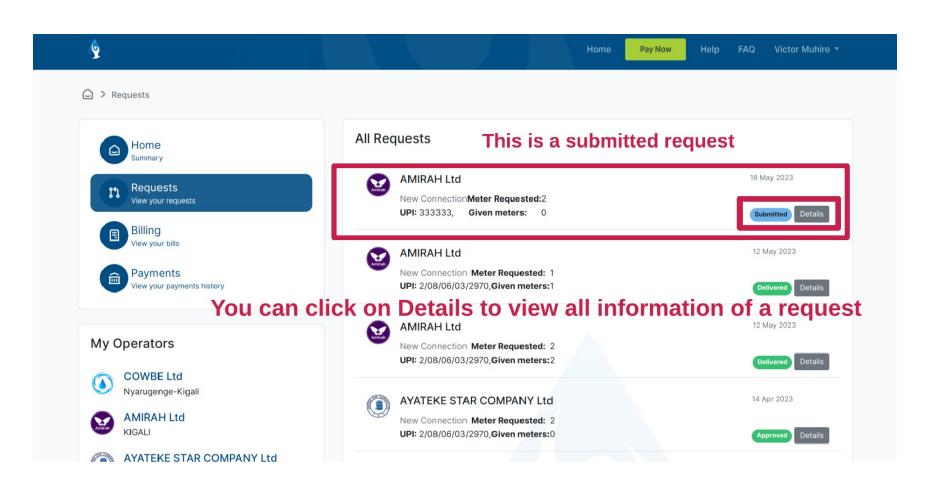

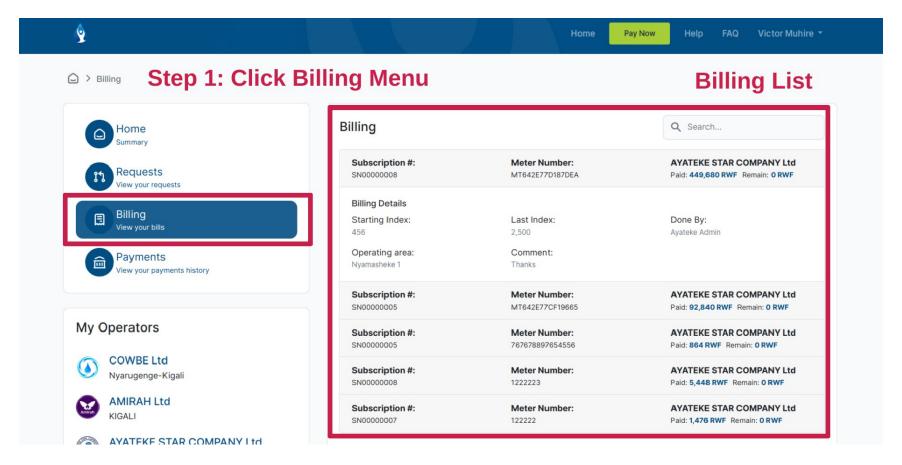


Step 5: Fill out the form accordingly

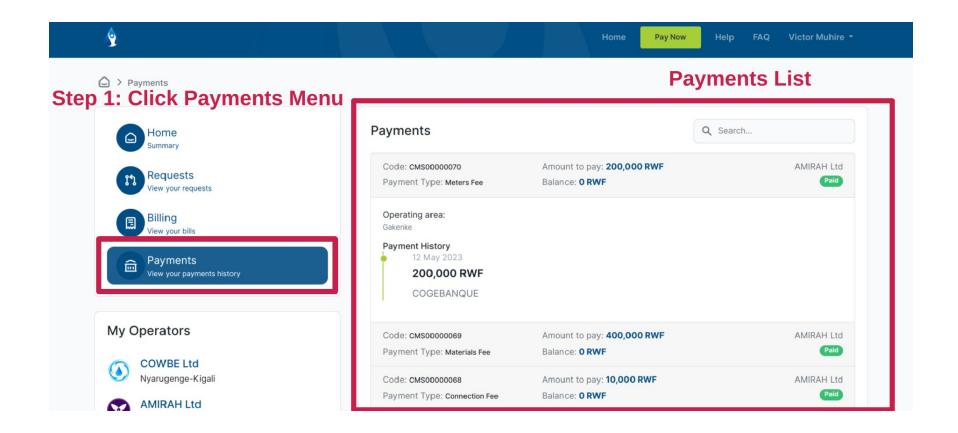


Billings: The system should allow customers to make payments through various payment methods such as mobile money or bank payment. The system should update the customer's account balance after the payment is received

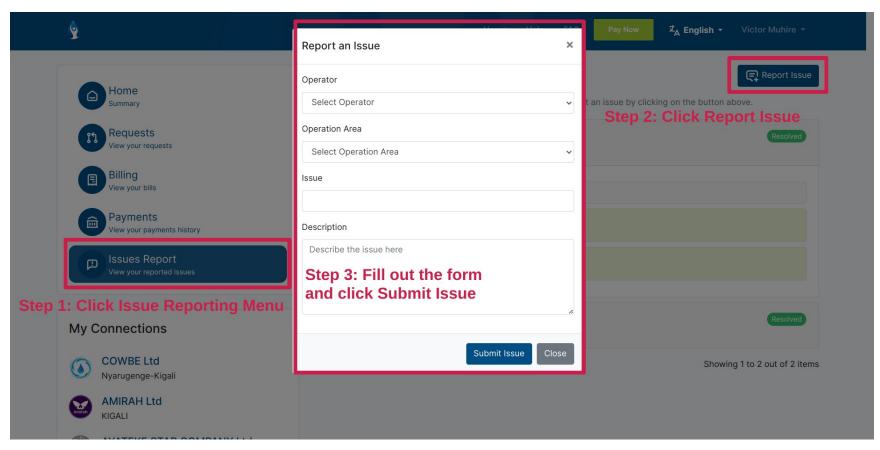


Step 1: Click Billing Menu

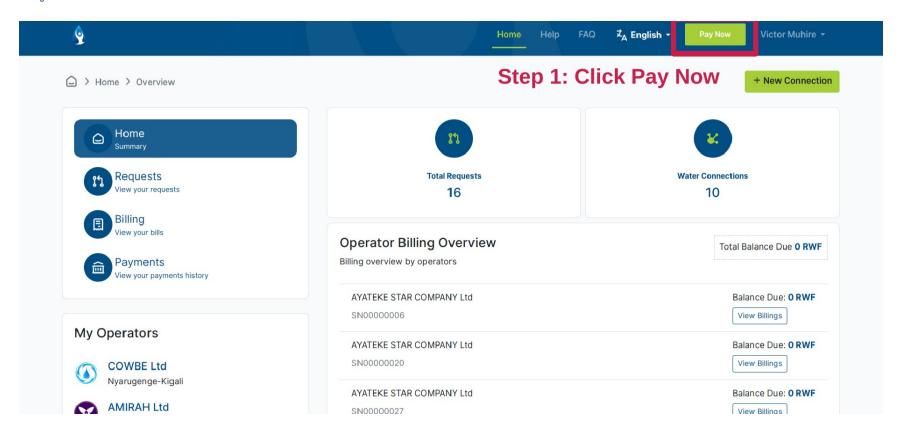


Step 1: Click Issues Reporting Menu

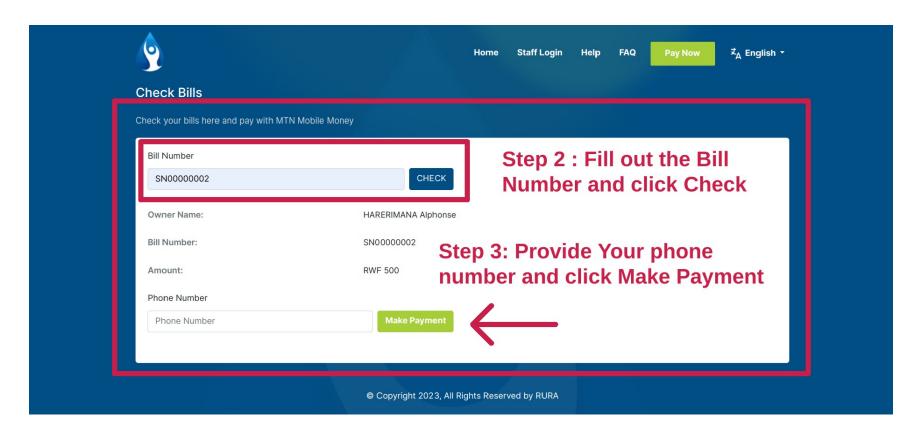

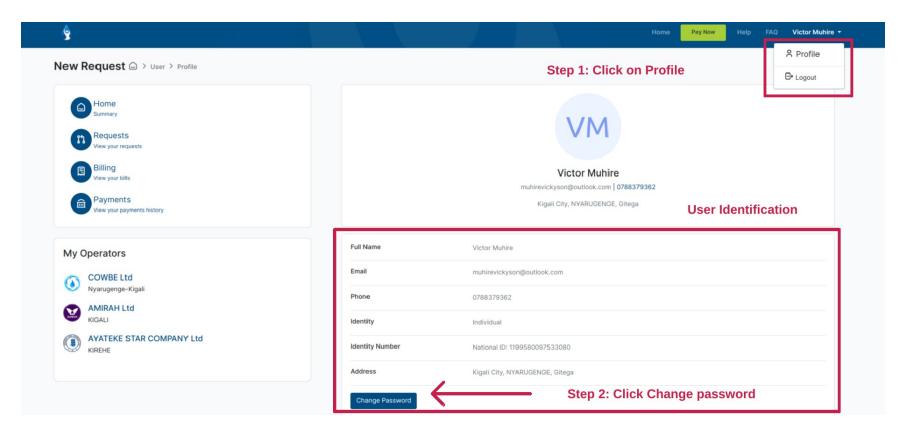
Step 1: Click Pay Now



Step 2: Fill out the Bill Number and click Check

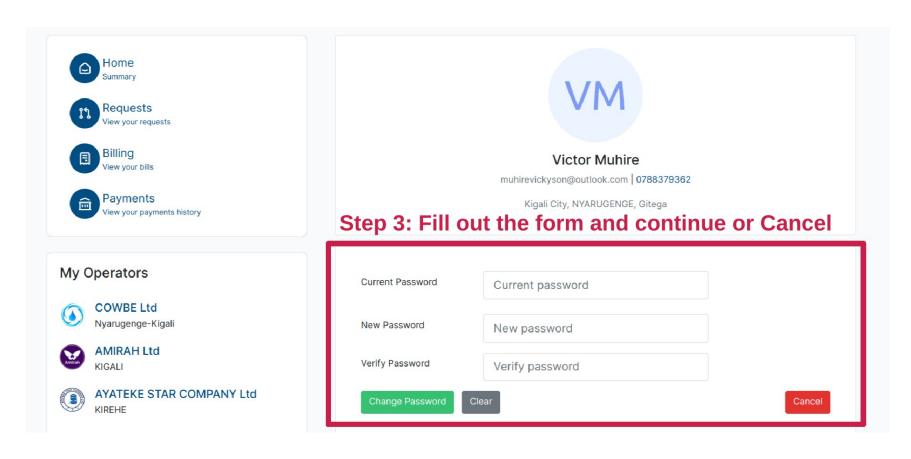
